Drawings and photographs are not to scale but illustrate the specific design and shape.

The above is for **front and side windows**; for rear windows it needs a case by case basis, so for instance Waller and Jerningham are of the simple curve design, but Pepys and Erlanger follow the same design as the front horns. Generally side windows where visible from the public realm followed the design of the front windows.
